COVID-19 Emergency Assistance Grants to Students
From Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF)
June 15, 2020 Report

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act includes a Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) that provides emergency funding to higher education. Healing Hands School of Holistic Health has signed and returned the Certification and Agreement form to the Department of Education. Following Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students, Healing Hands School intends to use the funds to provide the mandated amount of at least 50% of the emergency financial aid grants to students.

- The total amount of funds that the institution has received under the HEERF student portion: \$91,899
- Of those funds, the total amount that has been distributed to students as of the date of reporting: As of June 15, 2020, \$0 funds have been disbursed to students. The application to request Emergency Assistance Grants is still open for students to submit.
- The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and therefore eligible to receive an emergency financial aid grant: We estimate 250 students could be eligible.
- The total number of students who have received an emergency financial aid grant: As of June 15, 2020, the total number of students who have received an Emergency Assistance Grant is 0. The application to request Emergency Assistance Grants is still open for students to submit.
- How the institution determined which students will receive emergency financial aid grants and how much funding they will receive: On June 10, 2020, current students were emailed a letter and COVID-19 Emergency Assistance Grant Application. This fund is reserved for students who are eligible to receive federal financial aid and are actively enrolled in a program at Healing Hands. Emergency Assistance Grant award amounts will be based on the data from Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and Emergency Assistance Grant Applications.
- Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the emergency financial aid grants: On June 10, 2020, current students were emailed a letter and COVID-19 Emergency Assistance Grant Application.
